



Overview of Club/Association

The Serpentine Jarrahdale Mens Shed was formed in 2010 when Brian Phillips, a boat builder, who had worked on the Endeavor Replica in Freemantle, approached the Jarrahdale Community Association with an idea for a Mens Shed in the area. And so began the journey to where we are at now, in the Old Scout Hall in Mundijong, with some 70 odd members who devote their time two days a week, carrying out projects within and for the Local Community.

Job Title

Volunteers, from all backgrounds and experiences, come together to create items to sell or projects for various other groups within the local community. We regularly attend Local events with our Caravan and sometimes our Band Saw Mill to showcase our talents and to sell our products and services to the community.

Responsible To

The shed is operated by a committee of 10 Persons with a President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer forming an Executive Committee to steer the group in the desired direction. The Vice President position acts as Job Co-ordinator, responsible for Costing and Pricing all Jobs undertaken.
