## **Officer Comment**

For Shire-run events, where the Shire requires services to support the delivery of the event, community groups that have the capacity to provide these services are invited to quote and a fee is paid. This approach means that the community group provides the services as a Shire contractor (for insurance reasons) and it allows them to generate an income for their participation.

Examples of this approach includes:

- Heritage Country Choir Australia Day 2025 \$300
- Byford Baptist Church Australia Day 2025 \$360 (Shire also purchased all consumables for the group to serve)
- SJ Blues Cricket Club Australia Day 2023 \$599
- Rotary Club of Byford and Districts Australia Day 2023 \$400
- Serpentine Jarrahdale Lions Club Australia Day 2023 \$280 (assist preparation) + \$250 (coolroom hire)

For some Shire-run events, community groups are invited to have a stall at the event and promote their activities to drive membership and undertake fundraising. There is no payment from the Shire in these instances. Examples include when the Shire delivers the Seniors Expo or Family Week Event and are trying to connect residents with local opportunities.
