

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Following our phone conversation earlier today, and now knowing that council resolution is being sought, I can confirm that the following is required for the Tonkin Extension project:

#### **Road Dedication**

Attached for consideration by Council are plans depicting land required for the Tonkin Highway extension from Thomas Road to South Western Highway. In order for the project to proceed, the land shown shaded on the enclosed Land Dealing Plans (LDP) 9823-118-12, 9823-119-7, 9823-120-7, 9823-121-10, 2060-280-1 and 9823-122-7, is required for inclusion in the road reserve.

Main Roads Western Australia (MRWA) is currently working through the process with all stakeholders for acquisition to be finalised. To enable the land to be dedicated as road reserve, it is a requirement of the Land Administration Act 1997 that local government resolve to dedicate the road.

It would be appreciated if Council could consider the matter at its next meeting and provide the following statement in a letter to Main Roads marked to my attention. This will satisfy the requirements at the Department of Planning, Lands and Heritage (DPLH).


